Ama Yangri is the divine deity who is believed to be the protector of the Helambu area. On the full moon day of Chaitra, the devotees flow around the region and country to get to Ama Yangri as a part of the ritual. They witness the sunrise and the lamas pay homage to the mother porter by carrying out hours-long prayers. Moreover, the locals enjoy butter tea, barley beer, and local wine.

This trek offers fascinating natural and cultural heritage, along with vistas of the mighty mountains and green landscapes. Trekking rewards include exquisite Langtang Lirung, Gauri Shankar, and Jugal Himal.

How can one miss the warm hospitality of the Sherpa and Tamang inhabitants of this area? Experiencing their way of life and witnessing their tradition is indeed a once-in-a-lifetime experience. Additionally, you can explore the Yangri Peak Monastery, which is a sacred site believed to have mystical powers.
