
Trip Overview




Offering unspoiled wilderness and breathtaking views of Manaslu (8163 m), Shringi Himal (7161 m), Cheo Himal (6812 m), Himlung Himal (7126 m), Ganesh Himal II (7118 m), and Himalchuli (7893 m) along the trail, the trekking destination has become on the bucket list of many adventure seekers.




1. How long does it take for the Manaslu Circuit trek?

Manaslu Circuit Trek is an 18-day package with Pure Adventure Nepal, exploring glacial lakes, the Tibetan border, splendid views of the Manaslu massif, and crossing the challenging Larkya la Pass.

2. Is the Manaslu Circuit trek difficult?

The Manaslu Circuit Trek is enduring and demanding, and the difficulty level ranges from moderate to strenuous as you ascend steeper climbs on the well-maintained and rugged trail.

3. How many people lost their lives in Killer Mountain Manaslu?

To date, the record of people who died on a demanding climb to Mount Manaslu is around 88. Acclimatize properly and even stay updated with weather forecasts when climbing and trekking Manaslu in the high-altitude meadows.

4. Where do I start the Manaslu Circuit trek?

The starting point of the Manaslu Circuit Trek is Machha Khola, which takes around 9 to 10 hours by road from the capital of Nepal, Kathmandu.

5. How high is the Manaslu Circuit trek?

Expect to climb at an altitude of 5160 m above sea level. The best trekking on the offbeat path leads you to Larkya La Pass, which is a must-do adventure.
